

FAL Automatic Rifle is a gas operated weapon which shows closed bolt and it is positively bolted. It is a light weapon and it allows the immediate performance of an intense fire. It is usually operated on semi-automatic mode (single shot). The automatic shot can be performed under good conditions of stability.
